

Fragments of the ESTATE “the court” (D. THIEVES):

Preserved as fragments. Symmetrically, on both sides of the entrance gate at the end of the XIX century were built two original outbuildings (stables away horses). In 1895-1897, a distillery was built, later there was a starch plant. The buildings are built in traditional for the Minsk region architectural forms of boulders and red bricks.

These are the monuments of economic architecture of eclecticism.

Analysis of the few archival sources of the late XIX – early XX centuries showed that industrial and economic structures in D. the Thieves belonged to the manor Delilovich. The owner of the estate during this period was Alfred slime. In 1896 was made part of real property among the heirs, which manor was given to Henry the Alfredovich Slizany. In 1908, Delilovich was sold to count Joseph Tyszkiewicz from Logoysk line.
