

The REMAINS of the ENTRANCE GATE (D. STIG):

Estate Yakima of Hreptovich in 1776 became the property of Michael the Slug, the Marshal office of Barysau. Slime-gentry family private coat of arms in the Grand Duchy of Lithuania. The estate was created by the Slugs, which, as stressed by R. Attanasi (1886), were good hosts and well-known collectors.

Joseph slug collected plants. He built special greenhouses and greenhouses, which were collected about 3500 plant names. Exotic plants were grown indoors on the ground. There was a menagerie and aviaries with birds. Look at the created Slime Botanical garden and menagerie came even foreign guests. On the territory of the estate still live grape snails-a famous delicacy, which was loved by the nobles in the XVIII century. He owned a library consisting of seven thousand books, works of art and sculpture.

The estate was built in the style of classicism. On an area of more than 6 hectares was laid landscape Park with a small pond. The center of the composition was a rectangular wooden house. At the end of the Park the axis of the composition was closed by a chapel.

The yard was covered by a high fence of boulders and rubble stone. Direct entry Avenue manor was associated with the village of Delilovich. The entrance to the front yard was fixed by a gate.
