

CHURCH (BORISOV)

The first Church in Borisov was built by Borisov elder Adam Kazanovich in 1642. In 1806, the wooden Church burned down. At the same place in the same year the construction of a new stone Church was started. Construction was completed in 1823. The Church was engaged not only in religious activities, but also charity and education. Under his guidance and care was a hospital with 27 beds and an elementary school with 80 students. Every Friday the Church celebrated a funeral Liturgy for the souls of Vladislav IV, the king of Poland and the founder of the Church Adam Kazanovich.

The Church is a monument of architecture of late classicism.
