

The FORMER TREASURY BUILDING (BORISOV)

According to written sources, in 1806-1807 the house of the noble Assembly was built on the square from Polotsk street. During the Patriotic war of 1812 the house burned down. In the funds Of the national historical archive of Belarus identified documents dated 1846-1850gg., according to which July 2, 1846 was signed a contract for a contract with the merchant Borisov 3-Guild Simh GALANT to rebuild the Treasury building in Borisov. The Treasury building on the square in Borisov is mentioned in the archival document concerning construction of shops in 1852. Until recently, it housed the Suburban village Council. Today the building is used as a Sunday school at the Cathedral of the resurrection. The building is presented as an architectural monument of classicism.
